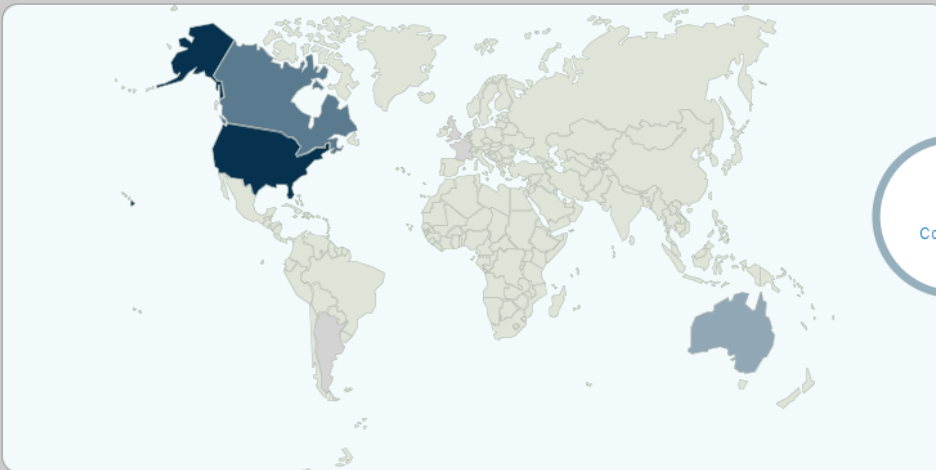

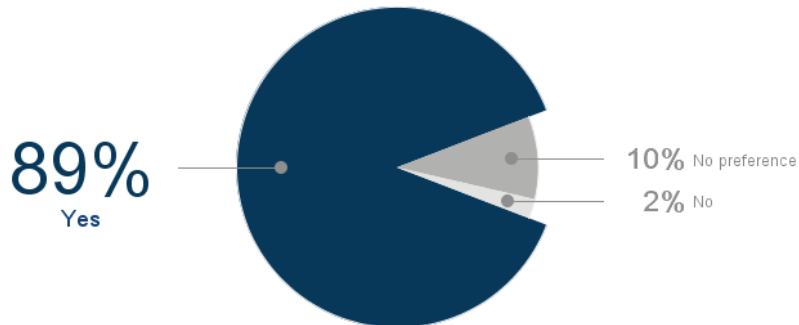
Do you obtain laboratory test results prior to a visit with your endocrinologist?



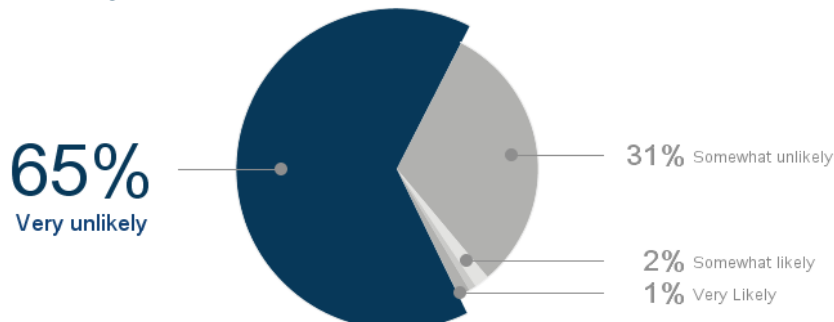
If you obtain laboratory test results prior to your visit with your endocrinologist who is motivating this behavior? Who is requesting test results in advance of your visit?



Do you prefer to have laboratory tests done prior to your visit with the endocrinologist?

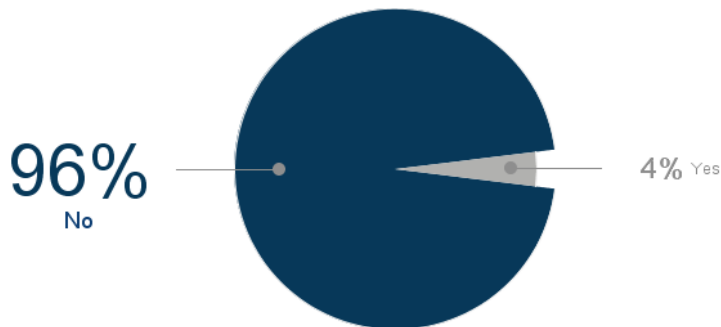


What is the likelihood that you would cancel an appointment with your physician if you have access to your lab test results?

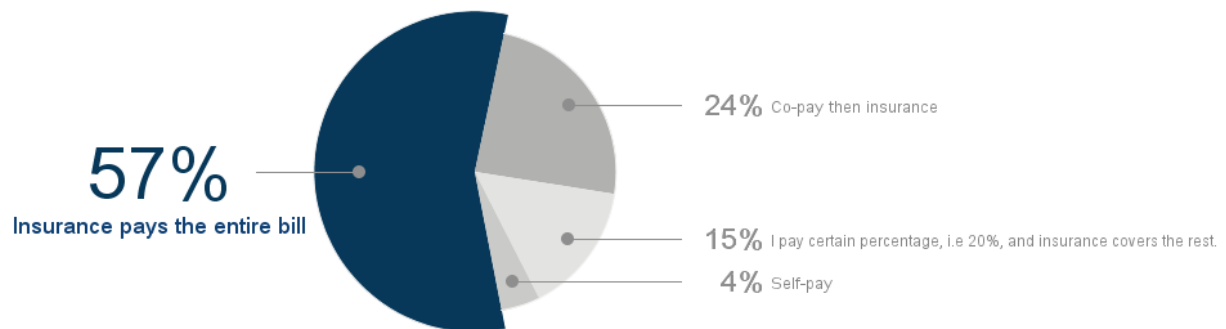




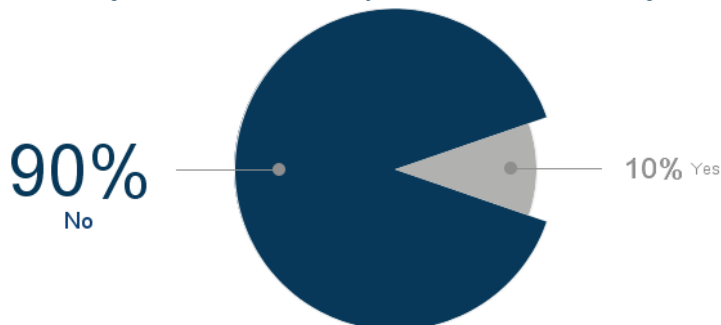

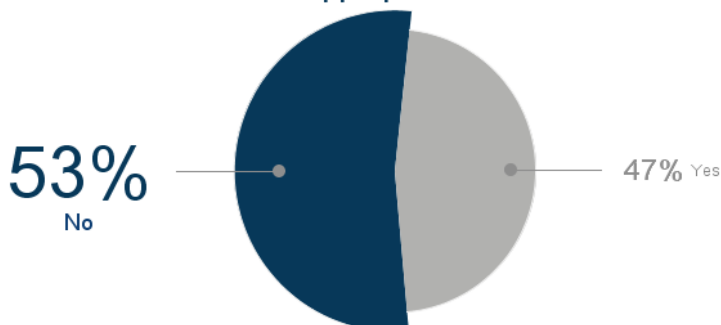
How are your laboratory results paid for?
